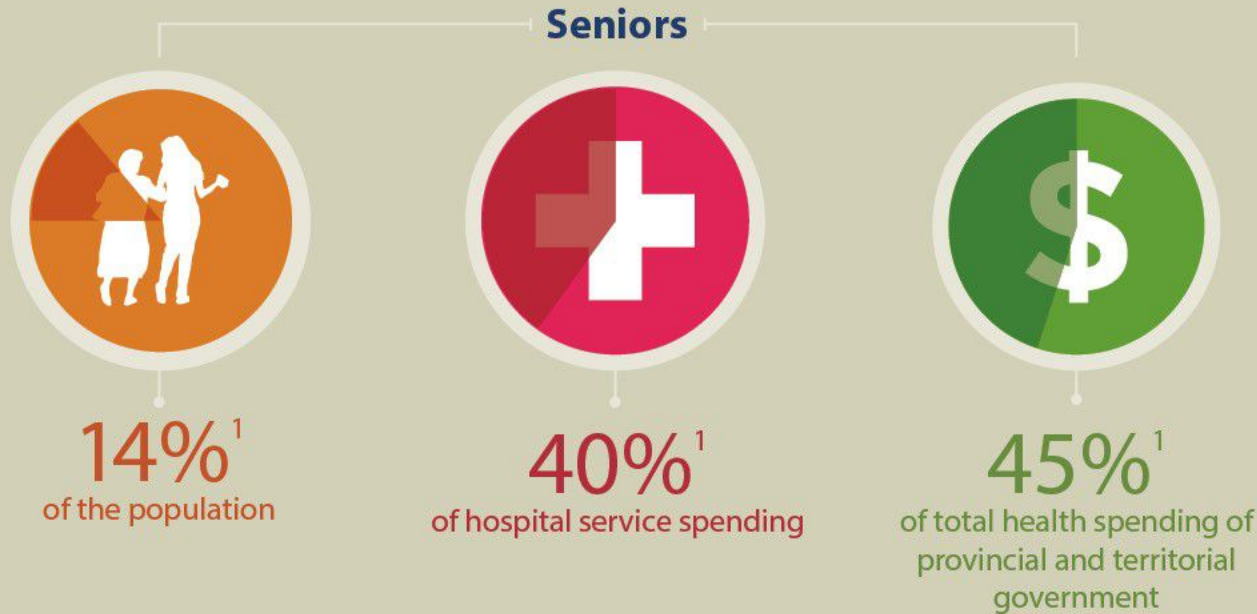


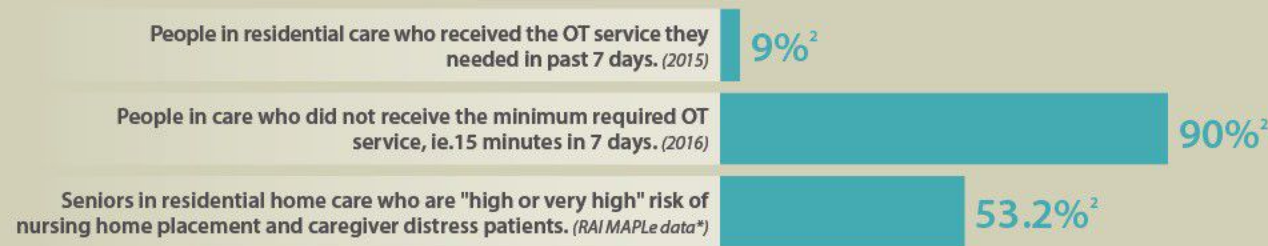
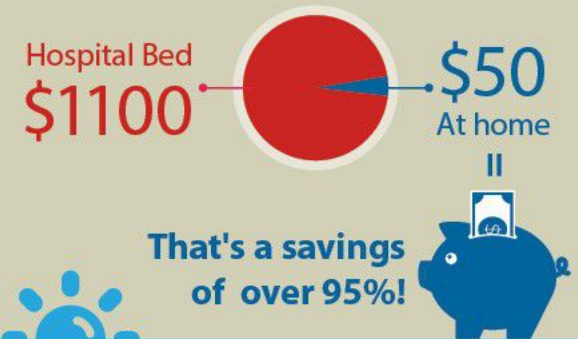
ENABLING SENIORS TO STAY AT HOME

*RAI MAPLe – Method for Assigning for Priority Levels:

- An instrument in a suite of instruments from the Inter RAI dataset used to collect and assess data by Canadian Health Authorities.
- Differentiates adults based on risks of adverse outcomes, ADL, Cognitive, Wandering and behaviour problems.

SOLUTION

Increase access to OT in residential care.

OTs are experts at daily living training, adaptive equipment and mobility.
